#### **PURPOSE**

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The following criteria will be considered by the scholarship committee in selecting the award recipients: Chinese cultural activities (25%), student and community activities (25%), and academics (50%).

#### **APPLICATION**

The completed application form and the supporting documents must be postmarked no later than **April 30** of current year. Please type or print neatly to fill out the application form(s).

Please attach a copy of transcript from the 9<sup>th</sup> grade to present, SAT or ACT score sheet, and major awards. A resume is optional. Please do not include with your application any documents not requested by the committee.
