PURPOSE

The goal of this program is to recognize and reward student achievement in scholastics, community service, self-reliance, and leadership.

AWARD

Amount of award will depend upon the Association's general fund and annual fund-raisers.

ELIGIBILITY

This program is open to TCCAA members who have graduating high school seniors with at least a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (9th grade to present) and who are planning to continue an educational program. The membership must be active on **April 30** of the award year. The applicant must know at least one Chinese Character.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The following criteria will be considered by the scholarship committee in selecting the award recipients: *Chinese cultural activities (25%), student and community activities (25%), and academics (50%).*

APPLICATION

The completed application form and the supporting documents must be postmarked no later than **April 30** of current year. Please type or print neatly to fill out the application form(s).

Please attach a copy of transcript from the 9th grade to present, SAT or ACT score sheet, and major awards. A resume is optional. Please do not include with your application any documents not requested by the committee.
